

Fuel Store

Important information for Support Crew briefers

The Club's fuel store complies with current safety and environmental legislation. You'll find it between the garages and the race hut.

Key points to be aware of:

- Keep the fuel store locked unless replenishing the stock or re-filling tanks
- The key is on the OOD's set of keys
- The jerry cans MUST be kept in the fuel store, never in the garages, whether they are full or empty
- **All other fuel tanks must be kept in the fuel store.**
- The fuel tanks with the small RIBs which are kept in the garages (not the Cages) should be always left in the boat, ie. **one fuel tank is allowed in each garage**, containing any amount of fuel
- **No naked flames or smoking near the fuel store**

Green jerry cans contain neat unleaded E10 petrol & have an **UNLEADED** label near the spout. This is for ALL engines fitted to the boats kept in the garages and the RIB cages.

Fuel from any other colour jerry can should NOT be used. Yellow jerry cans are now obsolete.

Red RIB fuel tanks also have an **UNLEADED** label

- Fill tanks a short distance from the fuel store, not right outside the fuel store.
- Place the fire extinguisher where you can reach it safely if necessary. Put it back afterwards!
- Check that you understand how the extinguisher operates. If you have to use it, direct the powder at the fire with a rapid fanning action, to spread the powder across the fire
- When filling RIB fuel tank, stand upwind to avoid any spillage onto you
- Fill RIB fuel tank minimum $\frac{3}{4}$ full with the aid of a funnel
