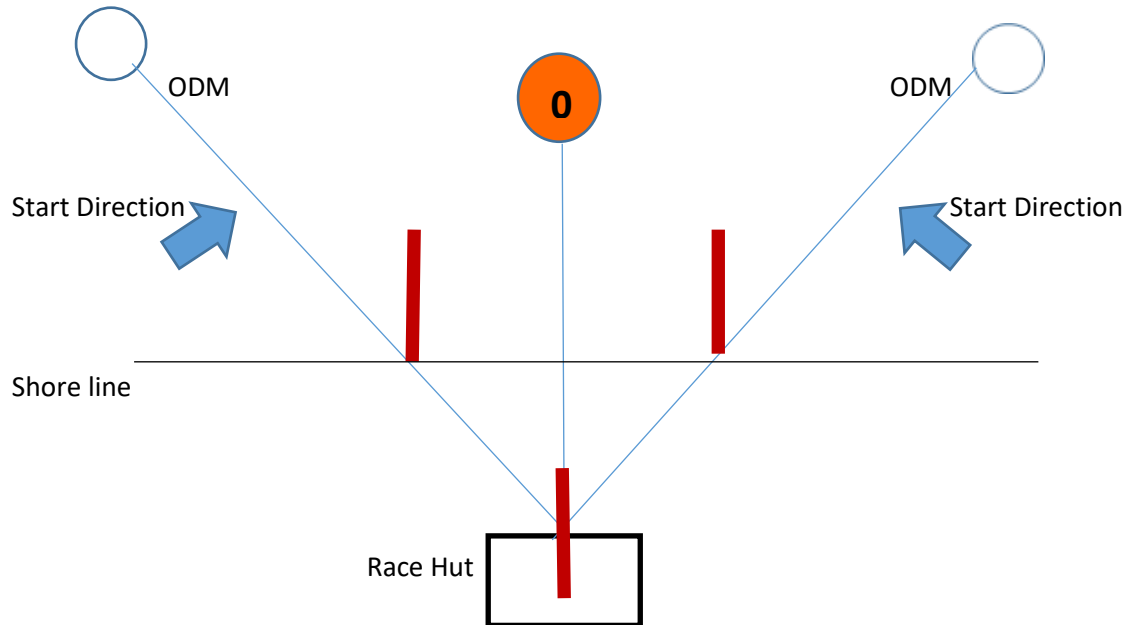


Race Box Start- Setting the Start and Finish Lines



- Set the white Outer Distance Mark (ODM) 75 metres or more from the shore
- Move the shore line pole to line up with the race box mounted pole and the ODM. This sets the transit for the start line. If the ODM drifts more than two metre to leeward from the transit, reposition the shore pole to line up.
- The start line is defined as a transit between the pole on the front of the race box and the pole on the shore line. The ODM defines the length of the line.
- Do not set a line with the ODM to windward of the transit, if you do you will almost certainly have General Recalls.
- There is no Inner Distance Mark, this is the shore line.
- Set the Orange Finish Mark '0' square to and directly in front of the race box.
- Make sure the finish buoy '0' is displayed as a mark of the course
